#### 1585 Shri Mahendra Bhatt:

Will the Minister of Rural Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of people who have been benefited from the Prime Minister's GaribKalyanRojgarAbhiyan (PMGKRA) in the six States whose districts were included in the said scheme;
- (b) the types of activities prioritized for employment creation under the campaign; and
- (c) whether Government will consider including other States in the said scheme as well, if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a): The GaribKalyanRojgarAbhiyaan (GKRA) was launched on 20th June 2020 for a period of 125 days with resource envelop of Rs. 50,000 crore to boost employment and livelihood opportunities for migrant workers returning to villages and similarly affected citizens in rural areas. A total of 116 districts across six States namely Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh were included in the Abhiyaan and a total of 50.78 crorepersondays were generated during the Abhiyaan. State-wise person-days generated under the GaribKalyanRojgarAbhiyaan is given below:
