FUNDING OF IRRIGATION PROJECTS IN MADHYA PRADESH UNDER PMKSY (AIBP)

Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether an irrigated area of 5 lakh hectares has been developed across 10 projects in the State of Madhya Pradesh under the Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Program of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana;
- (b) by when the approval would be accorded, which has been submitted to Government, with regard to the inclusion of Sanjay Sarovar Irrigation Project (Seoni/Balaghat) in the scheme; and
- (c) the total funds received by the State so far under the AIBP scheme?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) In the state of Madhya Pradesh, 21 major and medium projects (14 projects and their 07 phases) have been included under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojna-Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (PMKSY-AIBP). Out of these, 18 projects have been completed. An irrigation potential of 8.17 lakh hectare in Madhya Pradesh has been created through these projects. Central assistance of Rs.796.77 crore has been released to these projects of Madhya Pradesh under PMKSY-AIBP since April, 2016.

A proposal for inclusion of Extension, Renovation and Modernisation of Sanjay Sarovar Project under PMKSY-AIBP has been received from Government of Madhya Pradesh. Inclusion of the project under the scheme depends on successful appraisal of the project by Delegated Investment Board, followed by approval of Government of India.
