Pubic health initiatives under Ayurswasthya Yojana

#### 167 Shri Masthan Rao Yadav Beedha:

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of initiatives implemented under Ayurswasthya Yojana to promote preventive health and community well-being, State-wise and district-wise;
- (b) the details of implementation progress, outreach, and beneficiary coverage under this component in Andhra Pradesh, district-wise;
- (c) the data on health outcomes, participation metrics, or behavioural changes at the community level in Andhra Pradesh as a result of the initiatives; and
- (d) the measures being undertaken to integrate the Ayurswasthya Yojana more effectively with ongoing national and State health programmes?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH

## (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) The Ministry of Ayush is implementing a Central Sector Scheme namely Ayurswasthya Yojana since 2021-22 having 02 components namely i) Ayush and Public Health; and ii) Centre of Excellence (CoE). Under Ayush and Public Health component, there is a provision to support the eligible organizations across the country to roll out of authentic classical Ayush interventions with the aim to promote Ayush intervention for community health care and demonstrate advantages of Ayush health care in public health. The scheme is being implemented across the Country and is not specific to any State/UT or district. The details of the projects supported under the Ayush and Public Health component of Ayurswasthya Yojana since 2021-22 is annexed at **Annexure**.

- (b) & (c) No eligible proposals have been received from any organization in the State of Andhra Pradesh under the Ayush and Public Health component of the Ayurswasthya Yojana.
- One of the key objectives of the Ayush and public health component of Ayurswasthya Yojana is to support the implementation of Sustainable Development Goal-2 (SDG2) and Sustainable Development Goal -3 (SDG 3) through the integration of Ayush systems. The primary objective of the CoE component is to support creative and innovative proposals for establishment and upgradation of both functions and facilities of reputed institutions to strengthen competencies of Ayush professionals in Education technology, Research & innovation and such other fields necessary for promotion of Ayush at national as well as international level. Further, under Ayush and Public health component, the proposals from eligible organizations are considered based on the following priority areas: -
  - ➤ Management of life-style disorders or any non-communicable disease (NCD) including mental health of public health importance.
  - Maternal and child health (MCH) issues.
  - School going children and adolescent health related problems and nutritional deficiencies with public health importance.
  - > Geriatric health care and rehabilitation.
  - Malnutrition with special focus on vulnerable age group (children, women with reproductive age group, geriatric population).
  - ➤ Highly prevalent/ endemic diseases/ topical diseases/ infectious diseases of a specific geographic area.
  - ➤ Mental health and de-addiction.
  - Proposal may be focused on other health issues emerging from time to time.
  - > Ayush intervention on disaster management.
