### UPGRADATION OF COIR UNITS UNDER MSME

### 1743. DR. DHARMASTHALA VEERENDRA HEGGADE:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) details regarding total number of Coir units provided assistance for procurement of plant and machinery for upgradation and modernization of units under any Scheme of the Ministry and funds disbursed to such units, State-wise;
- (b) total number of beneficiaries under Skill Upgradation & Mahila Coir Yojana (MCY) during the last three years and stipend released;
- (c) data regarding the total number of coir workers covered under the welfare scheme such as Pradhan Mantri Suraksha BimaYojana, the details thereof; and
- (d) the quantum and nature of financial assistance, eligibility, implementing agency and criteria for selection of beneficiary under the Coir UdyamiYojana?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

- (a): Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) is a demand driven Scheme of the Ministry which provides financial assistance for setting up of enterprises including coir units for procurement of plant and machinery for upgradation and modernization. State wise details of coir units provided with financial assistance under PMEGP since financial year 2022-23 areat Annexure I.
- (b): The total number of beneficiaries under Skill Upgradation & Mahila Coir Yojana (MCY) and stipend released during the last three years are given below:

(c): As per the available data, Coir Board enrolled around 46518 coir workers under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha BimaYojana (PMSBY) upto the year 2019-20. The year wise details are given below:

At present Coir Board is not implementing PMSBY due to absence of centralized database of coir workers across all states.

(d): The Coir Udyami Yojana (CUY) was in force upto 2017-18. Coir Udyami Yojana was subsumed in the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) Scheme during March, 2018. Though the CUY was subsumed in PMEGP, the Ministry allocated funds under CUY for settling the spillover claims. As per the available data, the year-wise details of Coir units assisted and subsidy released to banks under CUY during 2017-18 to 2020-21 are given below:
