**“Establishment of regional research institute under CCRAS or CCRH in  
Odisha”**

1763. Shri Niranjana Bishi:

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal to establish a Regional Research Institute of Ayurveda or Homoeopathy in Odisha particularly in Western Odisha under Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS) or Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH); and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor ?

**ANSWER**

- (a)&(b) There is no proposal under consideration to establish Regional Research Institute of Ayurveda or Homoeopathy in Odisha particularly in Western Odisha under Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS) or Central Council for Research in Homeopathy (CCRH).

However, CCRAS headquartered in New Delhi, comprises a network of 30 institutes across various regions of India, including the Central Ayurveda Research Institute at Bhubaneswar. Similarly, CCRH headquartered in New Delhi has 27 institutes/units and 07 homoeopathy treatment centers across the country including Regional Research Institute (Homoeopathy) at Puri, Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital & Drug Proving Unit at Bhubaneswar.

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
