**“DEVOLUTION OF CENTRAL TAXES AND GRANTS TO KARNATAKA”**

1826. SHRI IRANNA KADADI:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of funds devolved to the state of Karnataka as its share in central taxes and duties in each of the last three financial years 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25;
- (b) the details of Post-Devolution Revenue Deficit Grants and other specific grants provided to Karnataka, as per the recommendations of the Fifteenth Finance Commission; and
- (c) whether the funds devolved were as per the budget estimates or whether there was any shortfall, and if so, the reasons therefor?

- (a): The total amount of tax devolved to the state of Karnataka as its share in central taxes and duties during the last three financial years is given below:

- (b): The details of post-devolution revenue deficit grants and other specific grants (such as local body grants, disaster management grants and health sector grants) released to Karnataka, as per the recommendation of Fifteenth Finance Commission during 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 are given below:
