**INSTALLED CAPACITY WIND AND SOLAR POWER**

Will the Minister of New and Renewable Energy be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of installed capacity of wind and solar power;
- (b) the latest figures on electricity generated from wind and solar;
- (c) the total installed capacity for new and renewable energy; and
- (d) the details of targets met in generation of new and renewable energy?

(a) As on 30.06.2025, the installed capacity of wind and solar power in the country is 51.67 GW and 116.25 GW respectively.

(b) As per Central Electricity Authority (CEA), the electricity generated from wind and solar sources during last Financial Year (FY 2024-25) and current FYs (FY 2025-26) are as under;

<b>Electricity Generated (in Billion Units (BU))</b>		
<b>Financial Year</b>	<b>Wind power</b>	<b>Solar power</b>
2024-25	83.34	144.15
2025-26 (till 30.06.2025)	31.87	43.04

(c) As on 30.06.2025, the renewable energy installed capacity is 233.99 GW.

(d) As per CEA, the targets for generation of renewable energy during FY 2024-25 was 391.7 BU, however the actual generation during the same period was 403.64 BU.
