#### ROTATION OF HEADSHIP IN AIIMS, NEW DELHI AND PGIMER, CHANDIGARH

#### Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that in July 2023, a report was submitted to the Ministry regarding rotation of Headship in AIIMS, New Delhi and PGIMER, Chandigarh and it was accepted as well;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether it is a fact that even after two years of the approval of the Rotation of Headship, it is not being executed in AIIMS, New Delhi and PGIMER Chandigarh; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (d): A Committee was constituted to consider the proposal of Rotation of Headship in All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi and Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh. The Committee submitted its report on 13.04.2023. Considering the recommendations of the Committee, it was decided to implement the Collegium system for one year. Accordingly, AIIMS, New Delhi vide order dated 31.08.2023 and PGIMER, Chandigarh vide order dated 27.07.2023 have implemented the collegium system.
