SOLAR POWER GENERATION CAPACITY ESTABLISHED IN BIHAR

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the currently installed solar power generation capacity (including grid-connected and rooftop) in the State of Bihar, along with its percentage contribution to India's total solar energy generation capacity;
- (b) whether any project has been approved or proposed by the Central Government for setting up a Mega or Ultra-Mega solar park in Bihar, if so, the estimated installed capacity (in MW) of such projects; and
- (c) whether these projects have been linked with the Green Energy Corridor, PM-KUSUM, or any State policy, if so, the scheme-wise and phase-wise details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND POWER (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a) As on 30.06.2025, the installed solar power generation capacity (which includes grid-connected ground-mounted solar projects, grid-connected rooftop solar projects and off-grid solar projects) in the State of Bihar is 328.34 MW and its percentage contribution to India's total solar energy generation capacity is around 0.28%.
- (b) & (c) Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has not sanctioned any solar park in Bihar as no proposal has been received from the State Government.
