DEVELOPMENT OF ROAD NETWORK IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the objectives of construction of five kilometre long tunnel connecting Shiv Murti-Mahipalpur to Nelson Mandela Road, Vasant Kunj;
- (b) whether the aim of this corridor is to provide a completely signal-free route between South Delhi, Dwarka and Gurugram;
- (c) whether there is any plan for integration with existing expressways to enhance connectivity; and
- (d) if so, the measures that are being taken to ensure timely completion of work and reduce pollution and traffic delays in the area?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) For de-congestion of Delhi, especially Dhaula Kuan to Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport - Gurugram section of NH-48, the work of preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) has been taken up for the construction of tunnel connecting Shiv Murti (Mahipalpur) to Nelson Mandela Marg. It would be connected with NH 48 and Dwarka Expressway through an interchange.

Decisions of investment and implementation of the project will be taken based on outcome of DPR, fulfilment of the criteria, inter-se priority and synergy with PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan.
