THINK TANK DIPLOMACY TO STRENGTHEN INDIA'S GLOBAL INTELLECTUAL FOOTPRINT

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Ministry has initiated any think tank diplomacy programmes to strengthen India's global intellectual footprint;
- (b) the list of think tanks or academic forums supported by Government for foreign policy dialogue;
- (c) whether partnerships have been established with international think tanks for India-centric research; and
- (d) the plans to institutionalize annual strategic dialogues led by Indian institutions abroad?

(a to d)

- i. The Ministry of External Affairs provides budgetary support to the following two autonomous think-tanks to carry out research, publishing and engagements with domestic and international think-tanks: the Indian Council of World Affairs (ICWA) established through an act of Parliament, and Research and Information System for Developing Countries (RIS), established as a registered society.
- ii. Through the Policy Planning and Research (PP&R) Division, the Ministry also engages with other think tanks, universities, research organizations and academic institutions and supports research studies, conferences and seminars by these institutions on topics of relevance to our foreign policy. The Ministry also extends some funding support for foreign policy outreach initiatives/dialogues, including the Raisina Dialogue, Indian Ocean Conference, Global Technology Summit, Asia Economic Dialogue, India-US Forum, India-Japan Forum, among others. There is a strong participation of reputed international think-tanks and research institutions in many of these dialogues.
- iii. The list of think-tanks, educational and research institutions whose specific initiatives have been supported by the Ministry in 2024-25 is attached at **Annexure A**.
- iv. Our Embassies and Consulates also receive support from the Policy Planning and Research Division of the Ministry of External Affairs to participate in and promote foreign policy and strategic dialogues in their respective countries, including through engagement with reputed think-tanks and research institutions.
