2195# SHRI SANJAY SINGH:

Will the Minister of LAW AND JUSTICE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Gram Nyayalayas established across the country to date and the number of Gram Nyayalayas actively functioning, the State-wise details thereof;
- (b) whether there is any monitoring mechanism to regularly monitor the performance and functioning of Gram Nyayalayas, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any report available on the number of cases disposed of by Gram Nyayalayas and their success rate, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the amount allocated by Government for Gram Nyayalayas in the last three years, the State-wise details thereof?

ANSWER

(a): The State/UT-wise details of Gram Nyayalayas established and functional across the country are at **Annexure-I**.

(b) & (c): The Scheme guidelines provide for two committees at the Central and the State level respectively to monitor the performance and functioning of the Gram Nyayalayas. Apart from this, there is an online Gram Nyayalaya Portal, in which data is filled by the respective High Courts with regard to case institution, disposal, pendency details, date of appointment of Nyayadhikaris etc. The data is required to be uploaded / updated on portal by 5th day of every month. As per the details available on the Gram Nyayalayas portal, 331 Gram Nyayalayas operational in 10 states have disposed of 4,11,071 cases till 30.06.2025. The State/UT-wise details of the number of cases disposed of by Gram Nyayalayas are at **Annexure-II**.

(d): The Scheme is being implemented on reimbursement basis and therefore, the funds are not allocated State-wise. The State Governments, in consultation with their respective High Courts, decide on the establishment of Gram Nyayalayas. As per the extant guidelines, the Central Government provides one time assistance to States/UTs for setting up of Gram Nyayalayas, subject to a ceiling of Rs. 18 lakhs per Gram Nyayalaya. Further, the Central Government provides assistance for operating the Gram Nyayalayas for the first three years, subject to a ceiling of Rs.

3.20 lakhs per Gram Nyayalayas per year. The details of year-wise allocation and release of funds under the Scheme are as under:
