(a): In order to increase access to job opportunities for unsuccessful candidates in recruitment examinations, the Government launched the *Public Disclosure Scheme* in June 2016. Under the scheme, the details of non-recommended candidates who have cleared various stages of recruitment exams but have not been finally recommended for selection, are shared publicly on an online portal by the respective recruitment agencies. The same can be accessed / used by private / public employers for considering such candidates for recruitment in their respective organisations. The scheme is being implemented through National Career Service portal. UPSC has recently launched *Pratibha-Setu* portal on which private companies / PSUs / other organisations can register to access details of non-recommended candidates for considering them for recruitment in their organizations.
