Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Odisha is integrated into the PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan;
- (b) the major projects planned/executed in Odisha;
- (c) the departments involved in convergence;
- (d) the challenges faced in implementation; and
- (e) the support extended by Prime Minister's Office?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY
(SHRI JITIN PRASADA)**

- (a):** All States/UTs including Odisha are integrated into the PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (PMGS NMP).
 - (b):** As on date, 292 Infrastructure projects have been evaluated through Network Planning Group(NPG) mechanism at the Centre under the PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (PMGS NMP). Out of these, 18 projects pertain to the State of Odisha; list of these 18 projects is given at Annexure-A. Apart from above, Odisha has also evaluated two projects through the State level NPG mechanism i.e. (i) construction of Intake well and laying of pipeline for water supply to KNIC, Jajpur; and (ii) water supply to TATA SEZ at Gopalpur from Pipalpankha.
 - (c):** As on date, 57 Central Ministries/Departments and all 36 States/UTs have been onboarded onto the PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (PMGS NMP). List of these 57 Ministries/Departments is given at Annexure-B.
 - (d) & (e):** (Multi-modality, inter-modality, last-mile connectivity, integrated and efficient planning and coordination among different stakeholders have been the major challenges in infrastructure projects planning. These challenges have been overcome with the implementation of the PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (PMGS NMP). The integrated national level geo-spatial platform provides visualization of all relevant data and information required for timely and efficient project planning. The PMGS principle of 'Whole of Government Approach' ensures coordination among stakeholders. The Network Planning Group(NPG) mechanism ensures deeper coordination, last-mile connectivity and 'Whole of Area Approach'.
- An Empowered Group of Secretaries (EGoS) has been constituted for monitoring, coordinating and providing decisional support for implementation of the PMGS initiative.
