Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of doubling/tripling/quadrupling of Rail line works completed in Madhya Pradesh during the last three years;
- (b) whether third line work between Katni-Bina has been approved;
- (c) if so, the current status of the project;
- (d) whether doubling of this track will benefit industrial clusters in that specific area; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): Budget allocation in the recent years has increased significantly. Budget allocation for Infrastructure projects and safety works, falling fully/partly in the State of Madhya Pradesh is as under:

The details of commissioning/laying of new track falling fully/partly in the State of Madhya Pradesh during 2009-14 and 2014-25 is as under:

As on 01.04.2025, 24 Railway projects (08 New Lines, 02 Gauge Conversion and 14 Doubling), of total length of 4,740 Km costing ₹89,543 crore falling fully/partly in the State of Madhya Pradesh, are at various stages of planning and implementation, out of which 2,092 Km length has been commissioned and an expenditure of ₹41,401 crore has been incurred upto March 2025. The status of work is summarized as under:

The project of 3rd line between Bina-Katni (260 Km) was sanctioned at a cost of ₹2478 crore. Out of 260 Km length, 235 Km has been commissioned and work has been taken up in remaining portion.

The Bina–Katni section is an important and heavily utilized route on the West Central Railway. Due to increasing train movements and growing demand from expanding industries, upcoming thermal power plants, and a new oil refinery, the existing double line is operating under capacity constraints. To address the rising freight and passenger traffic and to reduce congestion and delays, construction of a third line between Bina and Katni has been planned as a necessary infrastructure augmentation. After commissioning of 3rd line, more passenger and freight trains can be operated in this section.

Railway projects are surveyed/ sanctioned/executed Zonal Railway wise and not State-wise/UT wise/District wise as the Railway projects may span across State/UT/District boundaries. Railway projects are sanctioned on the basis of remunerativeness, traffic projections, last mile connectivity, missing links and alternate routes, augmentation of congested/saturated lines, demands raised by State Governments, Central Ministries, Members of Parliament, other public representatives, Railway's own operational requirement, socio-economic considerations etc. depending upon throwforward of ongoing projects and overall availability of funds.

Railway infrastructure projects falling fully/partly in the State of Madhya Pradesh are covered under North Central Railway, West Central Railway, East Central Railway, Western Railway, Central Railway, South Central Railway and South East Central Railway zones of Indian Railways. Zonal Railway wise details of Railway projects including cost, expenditure and outlay are made available in public domain on Indian Railway's website.

Completion of Railway project/s depends on various factors like quick land acquisition by State Government, forest clearance by officials of forest department, shifting of infringing utilities, statutory clearances from various authorities, geological and topographical conditions of area, law and order situation in the area of project/s site, number of working months in a year for particular project site etc. All these factors affect the completion time and cost of the project/s.
