FREE WI-FI SERVICES AT RAILWAY STATIONS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Railway stations with free Wi-Fi services, State-wise;
- (b) whether Government plans to expand free Wi-Fi to more stations, especially in rural and remote areas, if so, the timeline and targets; and
- (c) the budget allocated and utilized for setting up and maintaining free Wi-Fi at Railway stations in the last five years, including funding sources like private partnerships or Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives?

(a) to (c): Almost all railway stations across Indian Railways have 4G/5G coverage provided by the Telecom Service Providers. These networks are also being utilised by passengers for data connectivity resulting in enhanced passenger experience.

Besides the above, free Wi-Fi services have also been provided at 6115 Railway stations.
