ESTABLISHMENT OF ICF IN KAZIPET, TELANGANA

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has planned to establish an Integrated Coach Factory (ICF) in Kazipet as mandated under schedule 13 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation act 2014;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has fixed tentative date by which the ICF at Kazipet will be operational; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) Indian Railways has planned to develop a Railway Manufacturing Unit at Kazipet, Telangana at a cost of Rs. 521.36 Crs which will be capable of manufacturing and maintaining a variety of modern Rolling Stocks. Significant progress has been made, with the civil and electrical infrastructure nearing completion and the majority of the machinery and plants delivered. Till July' 2025 expenditure amounting to Rs. 310.78 Crs has been incurred on this work.
