- (a) the total number of girl students who have been awarded scholarships under the Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme during each of the last five years;
- (b) whether Government has undertaken any evaluation to assess the socio-economic impact of the scheme on the families of ex-servicemen, widows, and dependents of armed forces personnel;

(a) Presently 5500 fresh scholarships (2750 each for boys and girls) are awarded each year under the Prime Minster's Scholarship Scheme (PMSS) for the wards and widows of Ex-Servicemen. The total number of girl students awarded scholarships under PMSS during last five years is as under:-
