SOUND BARRIERS ALONG RRTS CORRIDOR

2455. SHRI S NIRANJAN REDDY:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) has installed sound barriers along the Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridor as recommended by the Fifth Report of the Standing Committee on Housing and Urban Affairs (2024-25);
- (b) if so, the details of sound barriers installed thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) whether this sound-proofing technology has been indigenously developed or imported from other countries?

- (a) to (c): National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC), the implementing agency for Namo Bharat Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridor, has informed that as per the study conducted by Central Road Research Institute (CRRI), the noise levels are within the permissible levels and therefore, no sound barriers are envisaged in the operational stretch of the Delhi-Meerut Namo Bharat Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridor.
