TAP WATER SUPPLY UNDER JJM IN MAHARASHTRA

Will the Minister of *Jal Shakti* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government has implemented Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) since 2019 to provide tap water supply to every rural household in the country with adequate quantity on regular and long-term basis;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the district-wise details of households, including Nanded district, getting tap water supply in the State of Maharashtra under JJM as on date?

(a) & (b) Drinking water is a State subject. The power to plan, design, approve and implement drinking water supply schemes/projects lies with State Government. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical and financial assistance. Government of India, in partnership with States/UTs is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission, since August, 2019, to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household in the country. Under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), the Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation provides financial, policy guidance and technical assistance to the States and Union Territories for implementing their drinking water supply schemes.

Significant progress has been made in the country since the launch of JJM, towards enhancing access to tap water for rural households. At the start of JJM in August 2019, only 3.23 Crore (16.71%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. So far, as reported by State/UTs, more than 12.44 Crore additional rural households have been provided with tap water connections under JJM. Thus, as on 06.08.2025, out of 19.36 Crore rural households in the country, more than 15.68 Crore (i.e. 81%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes.

(c) The district-wise details of households getting tap water supply under JJM in the State of Maharashtra, including Nanded district, as on 06.08.2025 is at **Annexure**.
