**SUPPORT FOR TRADITIONAL AND TRIBAL MSMEs
IN THE STATE OF ODISHA**

2491. DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of credit disbursal to MSMEs based in the State of Odisha under various schemes;
- (b) manner in which tribal artisans and handloom clusters are being integrated into formal MSME networks;
- (c) the employment trends in MSMEs located in backward districts of State of Odisha; and
- (d) any special fund or package for cyclone-affected MSME units in coastal region of State of Odisha?

ANSWER

(a): As informed by Reserve Bank of India, Rs. 44,950.44 crore has been disbursed to 3.66 lakh number of accounts of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise by Scheduled Commercial Banks for the State of Odisha during the FY-2024-25.

Further, in Odisha, Rs. 5,342.69 lakh Margin Money subsidy has been disbursed to 1,867 micro enterprise under Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme and 94,128 number of guarantees amounting to Rs 9,683 crore has been issued under Credit Guarantee Scheme of the Ministry of MSME during FY-2024-25.

(b): Government of India had taken numbers of initiative for integrating Tribal artisans and handloom cluster into formal MSME networks in the country, including the State of Odisha. Some of them are given below:

- i. PM Vishwakarma Scheme was launched on 17.09.2023 to provide end-to-end support to artisans and craftspeople of 18 traditional trades who work with their hands and tools.
- ii. Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) promotes clusters of traditional artisans through establishment of Common Facility Centres, procurement of plant and machinery and skill training.
- iii. Office of the Development Commissioner (Handlooms), Ministry of Textiles is providing need based financial assistance through interventions like product & design development, upgraded looms/accessories, solar lighting units, worksheds, etc. under Cluster Development Programme.

- iv. Office of the Development Commissioner (Handicrafts), under Ambedkar Hastshilp Vikas Yojna (AHVY) component of National Handicraft Development Programme (NHDP) Scheme is implementing for formalizing handicraft artisan clusters into Producer Companies.
- (c): As per Odisha MSME Development Policy 2022, Kalahandi, Nuapada, Bolangir, Subranpur, Koraput, Malkangiri, Rayagada, Nabarangpur, Kandhamal, Gajapati and Mayurbhanj are under industrially backward districts and the employment trends in MSMEs located in the mentioned districts of Odisha is at *Annexure I*.
- (d): As informed by Director Industries of Odisha, no special fund or package for cyclone-affected MSME units in coastal region of State of Odisha has been provided.
