SUPPORT TO COIR INDUSTRY

2496. DR. V. SIVADASAN:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount allocated and spent for coir industry in the budget over the last five years, year-wise, State-wise data thereof;
- (b) the money lapsed each year, year-wise data; and
- (c) whether Government plans to increase subsidies to coir industry given its significance in fighting climate change and environmental protection ?

ANSWER

- (a): The financial assistance for growth of coir industry is being given under Coir Vikas Yojana (CVY), Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) and Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI). State-wise allocation of funds is not done in any of the schemes. However, the state-wise and year-wise expenditure for last five years under Coir Vikas Yojana (CVY) and Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) are at Annexure I and II respectively. The state-wise expenditure under SFURTI for the last five years is at Annexure III.
- (b): No money lapsed under Coir Vikas Yojana prior to FY 2024–25. In FY 2024–25, Rs. 0.62 crore was lapsed and refunded to the Consolidated Fund of India.
- (c): At present, the Government does not have any proposal to increase subsidies to the coir industry.
