Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is a proposal to start postgraduate (PG) and doctoral programs in Ayush disciplines at Odisha's Government colleges under National Ayush Mission (NAM) support; and (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a)&(b) Public Health being a State Subject, the primary responsibility to start postgraduate (PG) and doctoral programs in Ayush disciplines at Odisha's Government colleges lies with respective State Government. Further, as reported by the State Government of Odisha, PG program is already started at three Ayurvedic Colleges as well as one Homeopathic Medical College and Doctoral Programs (Ph.D) in Ayurveda is continuing at two Ayurvedic Colleges in the State. The details are enclosed at **Annexure.**

Further, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is a provision of financial assistance to State/UT Governments including Odisha for upgradation of existing Post-Graduate Ayush educational institutions. Accordingly, State Government may avail financial assistance by submitting suitable proposal through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) as per the provisions of NAM guidelines.
