- (a) whether it is a fact that doctors from various AIIMS including All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi are leaving their jobs and joining the private sector;
- (b) the number of doctors who have left AIIMS during the last three years, the AIIMS-wise details thereof; and
- (c) whether any study has been conducted to find out the reason why the doctors are leaving their jobs?

(a) to (c): During the last three years (2022-2024), 429 number of faculty have resigned from various All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) including 52 from AIIMS, New Delhi. (Details at Annexure). Reasons for resignation of faculty are both personal and professional.
