STATUS OF HEALTHCARE FACILITIES IN WEST BANGAL

2671. SHRI SAMIRUL ISLAM:

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of new AIIMS and health centres opened;
- (b) the details of COVID-19 vaccination statistics, State-wise including West Bangal;
- (c) the Infant and maternal mortality rates trend in the country including West Bangal; and
- (d) the Health infrastructure and National Health Mission (NHM) funds to West Bangal vs national?

(a) Under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), till date establishment of 22 All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) has been approved in various States/UTs in the country including one AIIMS at Kalyani in West Bengal which is functional.

(b) The State-wise details of COVID-19 vaccination statistics is placed at Annexure.

(c) As per the Sample Registration System (SRS), Special Bulletin on Maternal Mortality, released by the Registrar General of India (RGI) the Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) in the country has reduced from 254 per lakh live births in SRS 2004-06 to 88 per lakh live births in SRS 2020-22. The MMR of the West Bengal has reduced from 141 per lakh live births to 105 per lakh live births during the same period.

As per the Sample Registration System (SRS) Reports of Registrar General of India (RGI), the Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) has declined from 58 per thousand live births in 2005 to 26 per thousand live births in 2022 at National level. The IMR for the State of West Bengal has declined from 38 per thousand live births in 2005 to 17 per thousand live births in 2022.
