PROMOTINO OF INTERNATIONAL CONNECTIVITY TO PORTS

2719. SHRI R. GIRIRAJAN AND DR. KANIMOZHI NVN SOMU:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is keen in promoting Cruise and passenger ship services from Chennai and Pondicherry to Sri Lanka, Andaman & Nicobar islands, Singapore and other international destinations;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is a fact that Cruise services has a business potential of ₹20,000 crore/annum in the next few years and if so, the details thereof: and
- (d) whether it is also a fact that Government is allowing foreign cruise companies to operate cruise services in the country and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) to (d) Chennai Port had 10 International Cruise Ship Calls in FY 2024-25. The Government of Puducherry had accorded permission to M/s. Cordelia Cruise, Mumbai to commence Cruise Vessel services to Pondicherry from July 2025. Subsequently, the Cruise Vessel "MV EMPRESS" of M/s. Cordelia Cruise, Mumbai has made three voyages successfully (Chennai-Vizag-Puducherry-Chennai). In FY 2024-25, 91 International Cruise ship calls were made at Indian ports.
