**TOILETS IN SCHOOLS OF RURAL AREAS**

**2791 SHRI JAVED ALI KHAN:**

Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of toilets constructed in primary, secondary and senior secondary schools and anganwadi centres in rural areas under Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) during 2025-26, till date, State-wise; and
- (b) the details of fund allocated under budget estimates, released and utilized for toilets in schools under SBM during current financial year till date, State-wise?

(a) and (b) After the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) on 2nd October, 2014, school and anganwadi toilets are to be provided by the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Women and Child Development respectively.

As per information provided by Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, Education is a subject in the Concurrent list of the Constitution and most of the schools come under jurisdiction of concerned States and UTs. State and UT Governments are the appropriate Governments and have the responsibility to provide infrastructure in schools including construction and maintenance of toilets. Under Samagra Shiksha the Government of India is taking targeted and Saturation approach for ensuring separate boys, girls' and Child with Special Need (CWSN) toilets in all the Government and Governments aided schools. under its Samagra Shiksha Scheme a total of 15,437 toilets, which includes Girls, Boys and CWSN toilets, have been approved for the rural area schools with the financial outlay of Rs.41,079.46 lakhs in the current financial year (2025-26). State-wise details of approval during 2025-26 is attached at Annexure.
