- (a) whether Pune and Gujarat state particularly Ahmedabad city is seeing a surge in cold, cough, fever and corona-like symptoms due to climate change;
- (b) if so, the details of patients affected and hospital admissions;
- (c) whether alerts or advisories have been issued for the elderly, children and immunocompromised; and
- (d) what additional public health measures are planned ahead of monsoon 2025?

- (a) & (b): Details of Influenza Like Illness (ILI) and Severe Acute Respiratory Illness (SARI) month wise in Pune and Ahmedabad during 2025 is annexed. Health effects of Climate Change are synergistic manifestations of factors, which include food habits, occupational habits, socioeconomic status, medical history, immunity, heredity etc. of the individuals.
