- (a) the number of Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AAMs) sanctioned and operational until March 2025, State-wise;
- (b) the number of AAMs expected to be operational by March 2026;
- (c) the number of AAMs providing digital services, district-wise and State-wise;
- (d) the number of skilled birth attendants working in AAMs, district-wise and State-wise;
- (e) the number of AAMs providing teleconsultation services, district-wise and State-wise; and
- (f) the number of vacancies in AAMs, broken-down by types of health professionals, district-wise and State-wise?

(a) to (f): As reported by States/UTs on Ayushman Arogya Mandir (AAM) portal, State/UT-wise number of AAMs operationalized across the country, as on 31.07.2025, is enclosed as Annexure-I.

Operational AAMs are equipped with robust Information Technology (IT) systems to ensure efficient service delivery and data management. These systems include the necessary hardware and software infrastructure to support real-time data entry, service tracking, and reporting. Key digital platforms such as the Ayushman Arogya Mandir Portal, Health Management Information System (HMIS), e-Sanjeevani, National Programme for Prevention and Control of Non-Communicable Diseases (NP-NCD) Portal, and Reproductive and Child Health (RCH) Portal are utilized to capture various health service parameters.

Health Dynamics of India (HDI) (Infrastructure & Human Resources), 2022-23 is an annual publication, based on Health care administrative data reported by States/UTs. Details of sanctioned & vacant posts of health manpower in Sub-health centres and Primary health
