**STATUS OF PM SURYA GHAR MUFT BIJLI YOJANA IN UTTAR PRADESH**

3026. DR. LAXMIKANT BAJPAYEE

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the challenges faced by Government in implementing the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in Uttar Pradesh, the details thereof and the manner in which these problems are being addressed;
- (b) the details of registrations done, applications received, solar rooftop installations done and subsidies released under the scheme so far in Uttar Pradesh, district-wise;
- (c) the energy capacity (in gigawatt) achieved from the installed solar rooftops in Uttar Pradesh; and
- (d) the details of steps taken by Government and the quantum of budget spent so far for this purpose?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) The Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) is implementing PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSG: MBY) across the country including in the state of Uttar Pradesh since February, 2024. The scheme targets to achieve rooftop solar installations in one crore households in the residential sector by 2026-27.

The scheme is demand driven, and no state-wise targets are allocated. All residential consumers in the country having grid connected electricity connection of the local DISCOM can avail the benefits of the scheme by applying on the National Portal of the scheme.

In the state of Uttar Pradesh, as on 11.08.2025, a total of 12,20,955 applications have been submitted on the National Portal and 1,89,443 households have been benefitted with installation of rooftop solar under the scheme. Further, an amount of Rs 1264.57 crore has been disbursed as Central Financial Assistance (CFA) to the beneficiaries under the scheme. The district wise details are given in **Annexure**.

As of 11.08.2025, a total of 0.66 GW rooftop solar capacity has been installed in the state of Uttar Pradesh under the PMSG: MBY.

The MNRE and REC Ltd., as the National Programme Implementing Agency (NPIA), for PMSG-MBY, work in close coordination with all the State Implementing Agencies including the state of Uttar Pradesh, to identify the

challenges, if any, and take necessary measures for effective implementation of the PMSG: MBY.

Further, the Government has taken following measures to promote rooftop solar adoption under the scheme:

- Online process from registration to disbursal of subsidy directly in to the bank account of the residential consumer through National Portal.
- Availability of collateral free loan from nationalized banks at concessional interest rate of repo-rate plus 50 bps i.e. 6% per annum for the present with tenure of 10 years.
- Simplified the regulatory approval process by waiving technical feasibility requirement and introducing auto load enhancement upto 10 kW.
- Simplified process for registration of vendors to ensure sufficient and qualified vendors are available.
- Capacity building and training programmes being conducted for creating skilled manpower.
- Creating awareness about the scheme, through awareness and outreach program such as print advertising in leading newspapers, TV commercials campaigns, Radio campaigns across FM stations including regional channels, etc., in the country
- Regular monitoring of the progress of the scheme at different levels including with states/DISCOMs.
- Established grievance redressal mechanism for timely resolution of grievances. A Call Centre with telephone number 15555 is operational in 12 languages.

As on 11.08.2025, a total of Rs 14982.56 crore has been spent for the implementation of the scheme since its launch in February 2024.
