**RAMAYAPATNAM PORT IN ANDHRA PRADESH**

316. SHRI MASTHAN RAO YADAV BEEDHA:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress of works and the Central and State funds sanctioned and spent on Ramayapatnam Port;
- (b) whether Government has set any timeline for the beginning of commercial activities from Ramayapatnam Port, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the capacity of Ramayapatnam Port once it commences its operations; and
- (d) the timeline set for the Ramayapatnam port to function at its fullest capacity?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Ramayapatnam Port is a notified Non-Major Port under the administrative control of State Government of Andhra Pradesh. Government of Andhra Pradesh has informed that physical progress of Ramayapatnam Port up to June-2025 is 67.11 %. The total cost of the project is Rs. 4922 Cr. and expenditure till date Rs. 2302 Cr. The project is being carried out without financial assistance from the Government of India.
- (b) Government of Andhra Pradesh has informed that commencement of commercial operations of Ramayapatnam Port is scheduled for 24th April 2026.
- (c) Phase-1 Capacity is 34.04 MMTPA.
- (d) As per Port's Master Plan, the capacity of Ramayapatnam Port could reach 138.54 MMTPA by 2045–46
