REGIONAL TELECOM TRAINING CENTRE IN ODISHA

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry will consider setting up a regional telecom training centre or postal training institute in Odisha to serve Eastern India; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) There is no proposal, for setting up a Regional Telecom Training Centre or Postal Training Institute in Odisha to serve Eastern India, is presently under consideration.
- (b) There are three training centers operational under Department of Telecom (DoT) which primarily caters to the training requirements of entire country including Odisha. A Regional Training Centre (RTC) was established by Department of Post (DoP) at Bhubaneswar on 03.06.2020. The Centre has been operational under Department of Post since 01.12.2020 and primarily caters to the training requirements of the Odisha Circle. In addition, 17 Workplace Training Centres (WTCs) have already been set up across Odisha to meet ground-level training needs within the Circle.
