Progress and oversight of PM-DevINE scheme

3234. Smt. Ranjeet Ranjan:

Will the Minister of Development of North Eastern Region be pleased to state:

- (a) The details of projects sanctioned under PM-DevINE since its launch in Financial Year 2022-23, State-wise and sector-wise;
- (b) the total sanctioned amount, funds released and utilised as of June 2025;
- (c) whether any projects have faced delays or cost escalations and if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) steps taken to ensure transparent project monitoring and community participation in planning and implementation?

ANSWER

- (a) A total of 41 projects worth Rs. 5351.31crore have been sanctioned under PM-DevINE Scheme till 30.06.2025 since its launch in Financial Year 2022-23. State-wise and sector-wise details of these 41 projects are given at **Annexure**.
- (b) Against the aforesaid sanctioned 41 PM-DevINE projects, a total of Rs.1682.21 crore were released till 30.06.2025.
- (c) None of the ongoing PM-DevINE projects has faced delays or faced cost escalations.
- (d) The projects sanctioned under PM-DevINE are executed by the State Governments/Implementing Agencies (IAs) concerned in the North Eastern Region (NER) and the primary responsibility of monitoring and implementation of these projects lies with the

concerned State Governments/IAs. In order to further strengthen the monitoring mechanism and to ensure quality control of the ongoing projects under the various schemes of MDoNER inter-alia including PM-DevINE, the Project Quality Monitors (PQM)/Third Party Technical Inspection Agencies (TPTI) and Field Technical Support Units (FTSU) have been engaged by the Ministry in all the 08 NE States, who carry out inspections of the ongoing projects.
