- (a) the number of colleges and universities of Bihar where National Service Scheme (NSS) units are being run and whether Government is considering to increase the same;
- (b) the schemes that have been run so far by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) to provide employment oriented training to the youth of Bihar; and
- (c) whether any annual plan for Youth Leadership Training camps has been set in Bihar under Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan?

- (a): In Bihar State, NSS units are being run in 25 Universities and 415 colleges.
- (b): NYKS is not conducting employment-oriented training. However, the programme Education in Basic Vocations/ Skill Based Entrepreneurship Programme was conducted by NYKS across the country including Bihar.
- (c): As part of Annual Action Plan 2025-26, the "Future Youth Leaders Bootcamp" has been conceptualized as a structured platform to identify, train and nurture young leaders at the grassroots level under MY Bharat, across the country including Bihar. This initiative is designed to ignite a spirit of leadership, innovation, and social responsibility among youth, enabling them to become agents of change in their communities and beyond.
