MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

The Government of India remains committed to strengthening coastal security across maritime States/UTs including Odisha. Proposals for infrastructure are evaluated based on vulnerability, gap analysis in consultation with States/UT Governments. Government of India has sanctioned 18 Coastal Police Stations to Odisha under the Coastal Security Scheme.
