- (a) whether Government is aware of the proposed Aravalli Jungle Safari project in Haryana;
- (b) whether any environmental impact assessment has been conducted for the project;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether concerns have been raised regarding its potential impact on wildlife habitats, groundwater recharge zones and biodiversity; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken to ensure that the project complies with environmental regulations and protects the ecological integrity of the Aravalli range?
