- (a) the details of total mangrove cover in the country States/UTs wise;
- (b) the net increase in mangrove cover since year 2020;
- (c) the details of key promotional initiatives/achievements to ensure mangrove protection in last three years; and
- (d) amount of fund spent on mangrove conservation through National Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA)?

- (a) & (b) As per latest India State of Forest Report (ISFR) 2023, the total mangrove cover in the country is 4,991.68 km², which accounts for 0.15 % of the country's total geographical area. In comparison to ISFR 2019 and ISFR 2023, there has been a significant increase of 16.68 km² in the country's mangrove coverage. The State/UTs wise detail of mangrove cover as per ISFR 2019 and ISFR 2023 is given in **Annexure 1**.
- (c) & (d) As a part of Budget Announcement 2023-24, the Mangrove Initiative for Shoreline Habitats & Tangible Incomes (MISHTI) was launched on 5th June 2023 to restore and promote mangroves as unique, natural eco-system and for preserving and enhancing the sustainability of the coastal habitats. The objective of MISHTI is to restore mangrove forests by undertaking mangrove reforestation/ afforestation measures along the coast of India. The implementation of activities under MISHTI were started in FY 2024-25 and a sum of ₹ 17.96 crores has been released from National CAMPA to the States of Gujarat, West Bengal, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and UT of Puducherry for restoration of 3,836 ha. of degraded mangroves. Additionally, 22560.34 ha area of degraded mangrove has been brought under restoration under convergence with different Schemes including State CAMPA, MGNREGS and State Plans. The details are given in **Annexure 2**.
