Underground fire in and around the coal fields of Jharkhand

68 Dr. V. Sivadasan:

Will the Minister of *Coal* be pleased to state:

- (a) number of people living in underground fire affected areas of the coal fields of Jharkhand;
- (b) number of people who have lost their lives in the underground fire incidents. year-wise details data;
- (c) number of residents relocated from these areas including Jharia to safer place. Year-wise State wise data for the last three years; and
- (d) the amount spent by the Union Government towards rehabilitation in the last three years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF COAL & MINES (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a): As per the Revised Jharia Master Plan 2025, total 15080 families are residing at 81 most vulnerable sites which are unstable due to fire and subsidence in Jharkhand.
- **(b):** No fatalities have been reported due to underground fire incidents in these coalfield areas. Hence, year-wise data is not applicable.
- (c): The number of families relocated from these fire-affected areas, including Jharia, to safer locations during the last three financial years is as under:
