### MEGA INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN ARUNACHAL PRADESH, SIKKIM AND ASSAM

#### 694. SHRI BHUBANESWAR KALITA:

Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Mega Infrastructure projects that have been setup in Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim and Assam;
- (b) the manner in which these projects align with overall infrastructure development goals of the Central Government;
- (c) the role private sector is playing in these projects, and the incentives that are being provided;
- (d) the manner in which these infrastructure projects contribute to economic growth and employment generation in the respective States; and
- (e) the manner in which DPIIT is monitoring and evaluating the progress of these projects to ensure timely execution?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (e): Mega infrastructure projects significantly bolster the Central Government's vision by developing a robust, integrated, and sustainable network, spanning highways, railways, ports, and airports. Every Central Ministry maintains data on mega projects within their domain. As per the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, 7 mega projects in Arunachal Pradesh, 1 in Sikkim, and 10 in Assam have been set up. Details are enclosed at Annexure A. Further, as per Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region, 2 mega projects in Arunachal Pradesh, 5 in Sikkim, and 17 in Assam have been set up. Details shared by the Ministry are enclosed as Annexure B. The monitoring of these projects is the responsibility of the respective implementing agencies. However, in case a project faces difficulties in implementation, it can be registered under the mechanism of Project Monitoring Group (PMG), which is coordinated by the Department for issue-based resolution through inter-ministerial coordination.
