**STATUS OF NATIONAL URBAN DIGITAL MISSION**

**848. SHRI KARTIKEYA SHARMA:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the current implementation status of the National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM), specifically the number of cities and towns onboarded, live deployment of platforms like IUDX, Smart Code, and GMIS, and citizen services operational to date;
- (b) the range of services being provided through NUDM, from municipal asset registries and geospatial project monitoring to citizen grievance redressal and the depth of user adoption and satisfaction levels; and
- (c) the deployment of deep-tech solutions such as geospatial analytics, AI-driven insights, and predictive urban planning under NUDM, and plans to scale these across remaining urban centres to enhance efficiency and improve urban governance delivery?

- (a) to (c) The proposed National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM) is under consideration. The pilot implementation of the mission was launched in February, 2021, under which citizen centric urban digital infrastructure called the Urban Platform for delivery of Online Governance (UPYOG)- is being developed. It comprises a set of e-governance solutions usable by all ULBs for delivery of digital municipal services. The range and scale of services, platform adoption, and advanced technology integration will be progressively considered as the Mission evolves, subject to policy decisions and implementation readiness.
