PROGRESS AND IMPACT OF SMART CITIES MISSION IN ANDHRA PRADESH

852. SHRI SANA SATHISH BABU:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise list of cities selected under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM), including those in the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the total funds allocated, released, and utilised during the last five years, State-wise, particularly for the State of Andhra Pradesh especially Kakinada;
- (c) the status of works proposed, approved, and implemented in Andhra Pradesh cities, especially Kakinada;
- (d) whether more cities are being considered under the Mission, if so, details and timeline; and
- (e) details of impact assessment, citizen participation, urban scheme integration, and best practices documented?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS
(SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)**

- (a) 100 cities have been selected under Smart Cities Mission (SCM), including four cities in the State of Andhra Pradesh, viz. Amaravati, Kakinada, Tirupati and Visakhapatnam. State-wise details of cities is at Annexure-I.
- (b) Under SCM, the Central share allocation is ₹48,000 crore for the 100 cities. As on 11.07.2025, the cities have been able to claim central financial assistance of ₹47,459 crore (i.e. 99% of the total Central share allocation). The States/Union Territories are reported to have utilized ₹45,881 crore (i.e. 97% of the total Central share claimed).

In Andhra Pradesh, all the four cities have been able to claim central financial assistance of ₹1,860 crore (i.e. 95% of the total Central share allocation) and reported to have utilized ₹1,840 crore (i.e. 99% of the total Central share claimed). Kakinada smart city has been able to claim central financial assistance of ₹490 crore (i.e. 100% of the total Central share allocation) and reported to have utilized ₹485 crore (i.e. 99% of the total Central share claimed) as on 11.07.2025. Details of State-wise Central funds released and utilized under SCM, including State of Andhra Pradesh, since inception of the Mission, are at Annexure-II.

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- (c) As on 11.07.2025, Andhra Pradesh has taken up a total of 280 projects amounting to ₹6,589 crore under SCM. Out of this, 236 projects (84% of total projects) amounting to ₹5,701 crore have been completed and the remaining 44 projects amounting to ₹888 crore are ongoing. City-wise progress of projects in the 4 Smart Cities in the State of Andhra Pradesh is at Annexure-III.
- (d) No. With the closure of SCM on March 31, 2025, there is no further budgetary provision under SCM.
- (e) A mid-term evaluation study was undertaken by 'NITI Aayog' for 'Evaluation of Centrally Sponsored Schemes in Urban Transformation Sector'. As part of the study, SCM was evaluated, and the report was published in February 2021. Recently, NITI Aayog has initiated a Third-Party Assessment of the Mission which has already begun.

Further, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) had partnered with reputed academic institutions for conducting thematic impact assessment in the Smart Cities. The goal of the studies was to understand impact of SCM at City/ National level and compilation of learnings to be shared with other cities and used for any future urban development missions.
