Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government had conducted Pey Jal Survekshan (PJS) in 2022-23, as part of AMRUT 2.0 mission for water supply and sewerage management;
- (b) whether Government has engaged any agency to carry out the survey and the major findings thereof, the name and the contract amount earmarked and released for the survey;
- (c) whether the survey findings has been released, if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) whether Government has analyzed the findings of the survey and taken corrective measures, if so, the details thereof, and if not the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (d): Yes. An agency M/s Ipsos Research Pvt Limited was engaged by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs during 2022-23 to conduct Pey Jal Survekshan in AMRUT cities under AMRUT 2.0 at a cost of ₹16.96 crore (approximately) out of which an amount of ₹16.11 crore (approximately) has been released. The findings were communicated to the States/ Union Territories (UTs) in the workshop held on 22.11.2023 in New Delhi. During the workshop, discussions were held and States/ UTs were advised to take corrective measures.
