# IMPLEMENTATION OF SILT-FREE DAMS, FERTILE FIELDS INITIATIVE IN MAHARASHTRA

- (a) the total volume of silt removed under the Silt-Free Dams, Fertile Fields initiative in the State of Maharashtra;

# **ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Under the "Silt-Free Dams, Fertile Fields" initiative launched by the Government of Maharashtra, a transformative effort has been made to rejuvenate reservoir/water bodies and enrich agricultural lands. As reported by the Government of Maharashtra, over the past three years, approximately 6.65 crore cubic meters of silt have been removed from 3,040 reservoirs and other water bodies across the state. This nutrient-rich silt has been distributed across 1,58,686 acres of farmland, benefiting approximately 59,551 farmers.
