## NATIONAL RESERVOIR STORAGE MONITORING SYSTEM

Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

- (a) the manner in which reservoirs are monitored through National Reservoir Storage Monitoring System (RSMS);
- (b) whether the availability of water storage data in real time has been ensured under this system; and

(a) to (c) Central Water Commission (CWC) monitors live storage capacity of important reservoirs of the country and issues weekly bulletin through Reservoir Storage Monitoring System (RSMS). In RSMS, user id and passwords have been allocated to project authorities and regional offices of CWC. They enter their data directly by logging into RSMS. Data analysis and bulletin generation is done with the help of RSMS and is shared with the concerned Union Ministries, respective State Governments and other stakeholders. This bulletin is also uploaded on RSMS portal for view/use of public at large. This open access to information supports informed decision making by various Union Ministries and States.
