Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether ONGC has made any oil or natural gas discoveries in Baruipur, South 24 Parganas District of West Bengal, and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) total area of land acquired or proposed for exploration and development in Baruipur;
- (c) current status of the project, including any exploration, drilling, or production activities undertaken or planned;
- (d) whether ONGC has applied for a petroleum mining lease for Baruipur site, and if so, the status of this application, including approvals or pending clearances from the State Government; and
- (e) estimated potential of the Baruipur oil discovery in terms of recoverable reserves and projected production capacity?
