**STATUS OF MINORITY WELFARE HOSTELS**

(b) the number of hostels that are currently functional and the States where are they located?

(a) & (b) Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram (PMJVK) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme and one of the flagship programmes of the Ministry of Minority Affairs. The scheme aims at the creation of community infrastructure in Minority Concentration Areas (MCAs) across the country to address development deficits in sectors such as Health, Skill Development, Women Centric Projects, Education, Drinking Water & Supply, Sanitation and Sports. The objective of PMJVK includes improving the socio-economic conditions of the notified minority communities in the identified areas by providing better infrastructure and basic amenities. The total no of Hostels approved in last five years under PMJVK is 41 and the State-wise status is given below:-
