- (a): whether it is a fact that, during the current Rabi procurement season, Government has procured wheat more than previous procurement season;
- (b): the quantity of wheat procured by Government on MSP for the last five years and current year, State-wise, especially in Maharashtra; and
- (c): the number of farmers benefitted for the last five years and current year therefrom, State wise?

- (a): A quantity of 300.35 Lakh Metric Ton (LMT) Wheat has been procured for Central Pool during Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2025-26 whereas 266.05 LMT of wheat was procured for central pool during RMS 2024-25.
- (b): The quantity of wheat procured by Government on MSP for the last five years and current year, State-wise including Maharashtra is at **Annexure-I**.
- (c): The number of farmers, State wise benefitted from wheat procurement for central pool for the last five years and current year is at **Annexure-II**.
