(a) to (c): National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) has been registered as a Member Lending Institution (MLI) under the Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) scheme of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME). Under this scheme, guarantee coverage is provided for credit facilities extended by lending institutions to eligible Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs). Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS) and primary cooperative societies classified as MSMEs are eligible under the scheme.

On the basis of proposals received and their eligibility, NCDC has sanctioned 2 projects under the scheme till date as under: -
