**GST collection by Kerala**

- (a) the details of GST collection by Kerala State for the last three years and current year;
- (b) whether Kerala has seen an increase in GST collection over the said period; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): The details of Gross GST Collection (Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST), State Goods and Services Tax (SGST) and Integrated Goods and Services Tax (IGST)) by the State of Kerala for the last three Financial Years i.e. 2022-23 to 2024-25 and the current FY 2025-26 (till Nov, 2025) is given below: -
