PENDING WORKS AT AIIMS, BATHINDA

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has taken note of the pending works under Phase-II of AIIMS Bathinda, including incomplete hostels, nursing college infrastructure and allied facilities;
- (b) the reasons for delay in completion of these works;
- (c) whether Government proposes to expedite Phase-II construction and operationalisation of remaining facilities; and
- (d) whether super-specialty wings and additional medical services are proposed to be announced in the upcoming phase, and the timeline thereof?

(a) to (d) All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) has been set up in Bathinda (Punjab) under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). The Institute is functional with Out-Patient Department (OPD), In-Patient Department (IPD), Diagnostics facilities, Emergency, Trauma, AMRIT Pharmacy etc. The Institute has 39 Departments including 26 Speciality and 13 Super-Speciality *viz.* Nephrology, Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery, Cardiology, Radiation Oncology, Neonatology etc. Further, Medical College and Nursing College are functional with annual intake of 100 MBBS students and 60 B.Sc. Nursing students respectively.

The construction of AIIMS Bathinda was completed in April, 2022. Additional medical facilities, hostels and residential facilities are taken up in a phased manner based on functional requirement of the Institute.
